A wealth of additional content (optional) provides a wide range of customization options.

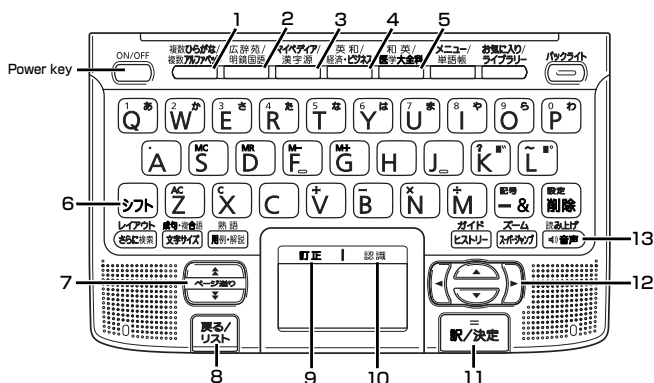
Native pronunciation

Using the keys

Key names and functions



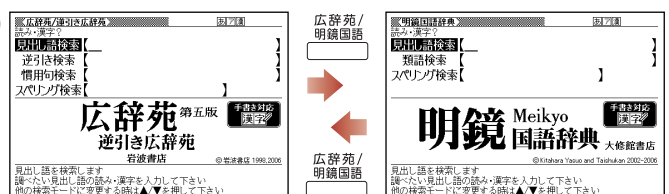
No.	Symbol	Function
1	電数ひらがな/複数アルファベット	Pressing this key toggles between "Multiple hiragana search" and "Multiple letter search".
2	広辞苑/明鏡国語	Pressing this key toggles between "Kojien" and "Meikyo Japanese-language dictionary".

No.	Symbol	Function
3	マイペディア/漢字源	Pressing this key toggles between the "Myedia" and "KanjiGen" encyclopedias.
4	英和/経済辞典	Pressing this key toggles between the "Genius English-Japanese Dictionary" and the "Economics & Business Dictionary".
5	和英/家庭医療	Pressing this key toggles between the "Progressive Japanese-English Dictionary" and "Home Medical".
6	シフト	Press this key to enter a question mark (?) or hyphen (~) or to use functions such as Setup and the Guide.
7	▲▼	When the information does not all fit into one screen, use this key to scroll up and down (Page Up/Down).
8	戻る/リスト	Press this key to undo the last action.
9	訂正	Pressing this key in the screen showing the meaning of a word displays a list of terms that include that word.
10	認識	Press this key to correct a character you entered on the handwriting panel.
11	訳/決定	Press this key to confirm a character you entered on the handwriting panel.
12	▲▼◀▶	Press this key to move the cursor (the highlight or the yellow line under the character) forward or back one step at a time and to select an item.
13	▶▶▶▶	When there is more text that will not fit onto the screen, hold down this key to move to the next screen.
13	▶▶▶▶▶▶	Press this key to hear the audio in another language.

Selecting a dictionary

Pressing the 1 to 5 keys toggles between the content printed above and the content printed below.

Handwritten input

Using handwritten input to look up the Japanese for English terms

You can write out an English word on the handwriting panel and look up the Japanese translation.

- Press . You can also select the "Genius English-Japanese Dictionary" from the menu. Check that "見出し語検索 (Search by keyword)" is highlighted.
- Use the handwriting panel to enter the word you want to look up. Using the touch-pen provided, write the word directly onto the handwriting panel. As you write the word, touch after each letter.
 - If the letter is not recognized correctly, press and correct the letter.
 - You can also enter words by writing several letters at once.

In this example, we will look up "fine". We enter the word one letter at a time, writing "f" on the handwriting panel and then touching before writing "i" and touching again.
- Press or to highlight the word you want to look up and then press . The corresponding Japanese term is displayed.

Using handwritten input to look up the English for Japanese terms

You can write out a Japanese word on the handwriting panel and look up the English translation.

- Press . You can also select the "Progressive Japanese-English Dictionary" from the menu.
- Enter the word you want to look up using kanji and hiragana or katakana. Using the touch-pen provided, write the word directly onto the handwriting panel. As you write the word, touch after each character.
 - If the character is not recognized correctly, press and correct the character.
 - You can also enter words by writing several characters at once.

In this example, we will look up "海". Write "海" on the handwriting panel and touch .
- Press or to highlight the word you want to look up and then press . The corresponding English term is displayed.

Keyboard input

Entering letters

When you are using a tool such as the "English-Japanese Dictionary" to enter text in English, the keyboard automatically switches to alphabetic input.

Alphabetic input keyboard



To enter a letter, press the key with the corresponding letter printed on it.

Looking up the Japanese for English terms

You can enter the letters in a word and then look up the Japanese for that word.

- Press . You can also select the "Genius English-Japanese Dictionary" from the menu. Check that "見出し語検索 (Search by keyword)" is highlighted.
- Enter the word you want to look up.
 - In this example, we will look up "orange". As you enter the letters, matching candidates are displayed. Here, when you enter "oran", "orange" is displayed.
- Press or to highlight the word you want to look up and then press . The corresponding Japanese term is displayed.

Entering hiragana

When you enter Japanese in tools such as the "Kojien", "Progressive Japanese-English Dictionary" or "Kanwa-jiten", the keyboard automatically switches to kana input.

(E.g.) To enter "みかん"

To use Romanized kana input, press the letter key (in this case).

"みかん" is entered.

Looking up the English for Japanese terms

You can enter a Japanese word and then look up the English for that word.

- Press . You can also select the "Progressive Japanese-English Dictionary" from the menu.
- Enter the word you want to look up in hiragana.
 - Here, we are looking up "魚", so we enter "さかな". As you enter the reading, matching candidates are displayed.
- Press or to highlight the word you want to look up and then press . The corresponding English term is displayed.

Native pronunciation

Listening to the pronunciation of retrieved terms (Audio function)

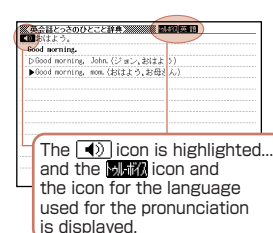
In the screen that explains the meanings of terms, you can also listen to the pronunciation of foreign-language terms, phrases and sample sentences.

- Compatible dictionaries: Cambridge Learner's Dictionary, Genius English-Japanese Dictionary, English Thesaurus, Tossa no Hitokoto English Conversation Dictionary, English Conversation Anywhere EB, Hyakunin-Isshu Collected Poems
- Supported pronunciations: Items for which pronunciation files are provided

- When the icon appears in the screen, press . turns to .

- When you press , the term or phrase above or to the left of the icon is read out.



The icon is highlighted... and the icon and the icon for the language used for the pronunciation is displayed.
